Julie Fry Speaks on the New 990

Dallas, Texas – Julie Fry, Chief Operating Officer of Salmon Sims Thomas was a guest speaker at the Free CPA Day sponsored by the [Center for Nonprofit Management](#) and the [Dallas CPA Society](#). Julie spoke to an audience of over 100 CPA's and nonprofit administrators on the topic of "Form 990 – Governance Issues."

The session was designed to give both CPA's and nonprofit management an in-depth understanding of the governance issues associated with the new Form 990. The revised Form 990 requires expanded recordkeeping and disclosure of information regarding the organization's governance and administrative policies. Julie emphasized the need for practitioners to devote more time and education to learning how to prepare the form. For the nonprofit administrators, Julie stressed the need to educate board members on governance issues and compliance.
